About Us

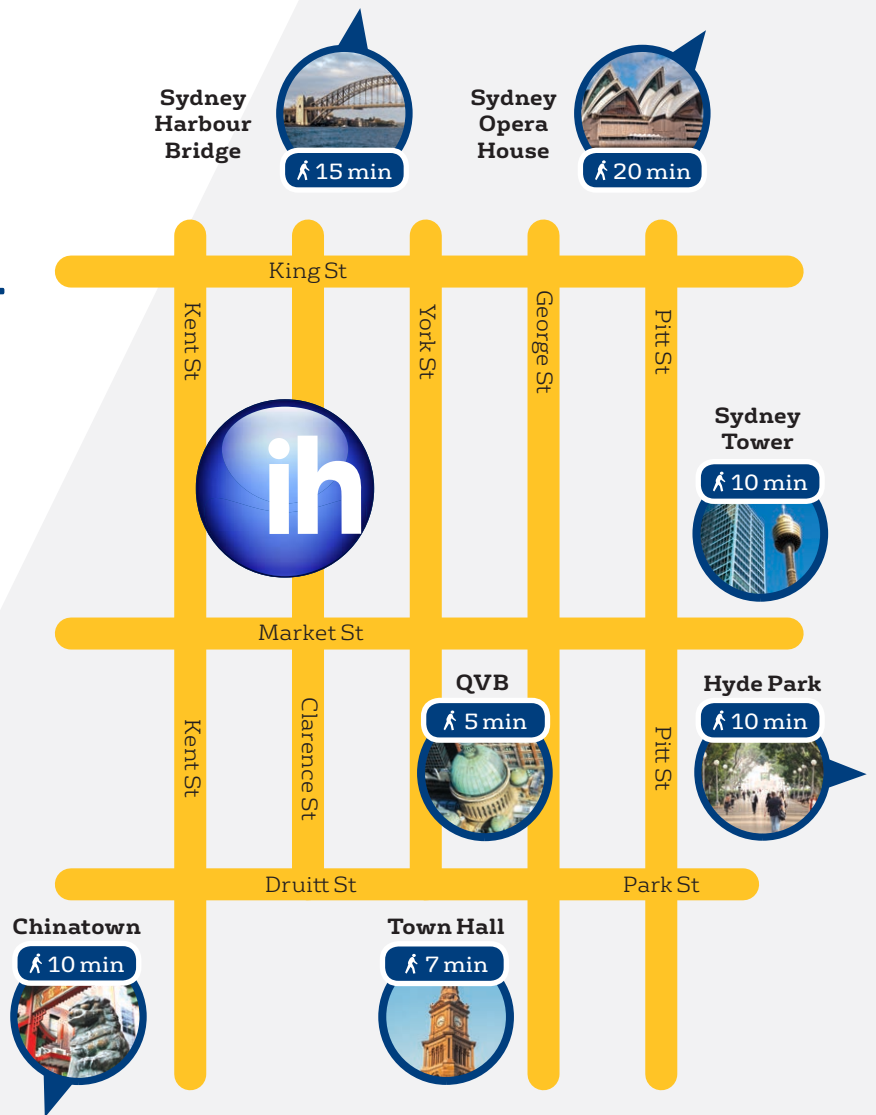

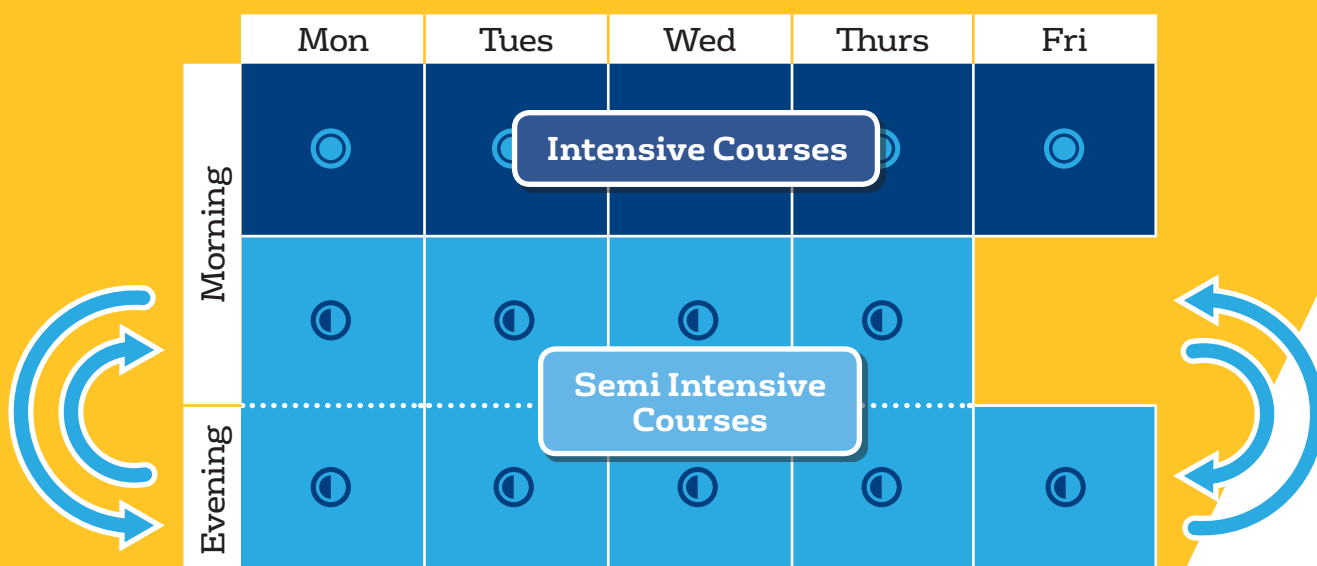

Cambridge English exams are accepted by over 15,000 universities, employers and governments around the world. The Australian Department of Immigration and Border Protection (DIBP) accepts Cambridge English Advanced (CAE) scores for most visa applications.

International House Sydney is an authorised Cambridge test centre. Students are able to take the Cambridge exam for FCE and CAE throughout the year.

Key Features:

- Comprising five practical, skills-based papers in:
- › Reading, writing, use of English (grammar), listening and speaking
 - › Practical, real-life writing tasks including writing business letters and reading authentic texts to build vocabulary
 - › Professional interview techniques
 - › Exam techniques and independent study skills carefully developed
 - › Certificate awarded by the University of Cambridge after passing the Cambridge exam

Entry Criteria:

- › FCE Preparation: Upper Intermediate level
- › CAE Preparation: Advanced level

Course Start & Duration:

IELTS (International English Language Testing System) is a worldwide recognised English test. Over 1.7 million candidates take the test each year to start their journeys into international education and employment. Prepare for the general or academic modules of the IELTS exam to enter an Australian university, or for immigration purposes.

This highly practical course introduces the current teaching methods, practical teaching ideas and a range of TESOL resources and lets you obtain a government accredited and internationally recognised certificate to teach English to adults. Furthermore, it is designed for non-native speakers who want to enter the English language teaching profession, whether they have any teaching experience or not.

English for Teaching Younger Learners

TECSOL

This course prepares students who have an Intermediate level of English or above to teach English to children aged 4 to 12 years. It develops students' own English language skills, and covers teaching methodology and activities with an emphasis on communicative ability from an early age.

Key Features:

- › Practical skills to teach children
- › Knowledge of how children learn at different ages: 4-6 years, 7-9 & 10-12 years
- › Classroom management techniques
- › Using songs, games, story telling, craft, puppets and rhymes in the younger learners classroom
- › Planning a series of lessons

- › J-Shine qualification available: add extra subjects in Japanese and work experience at a preschool

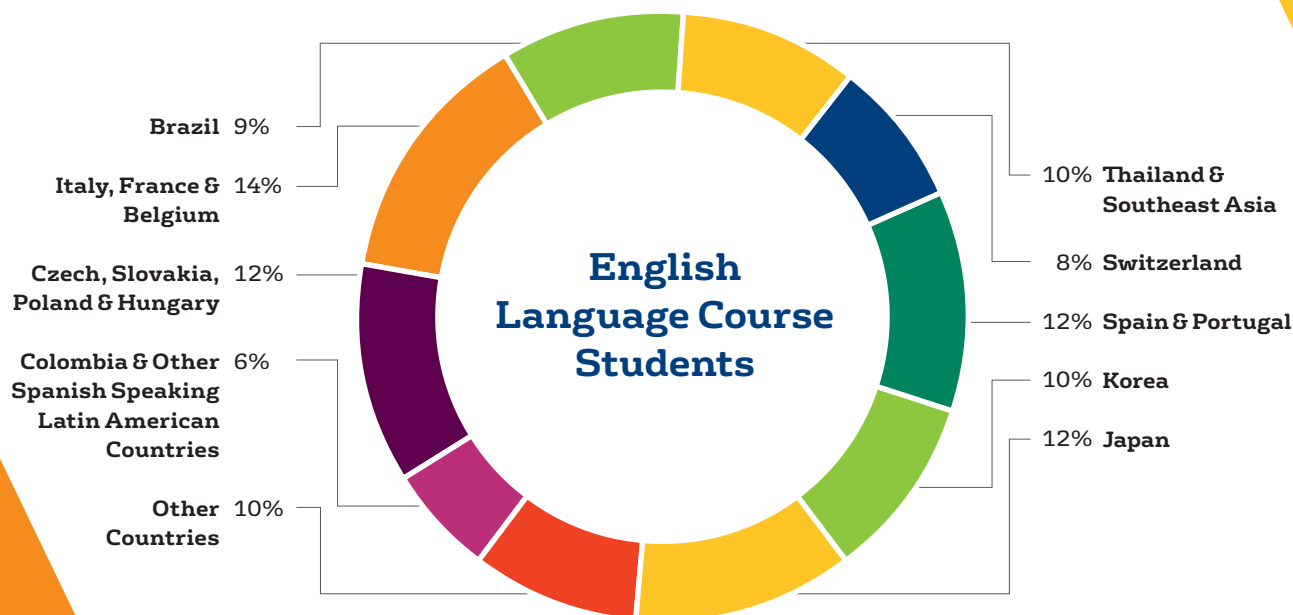
