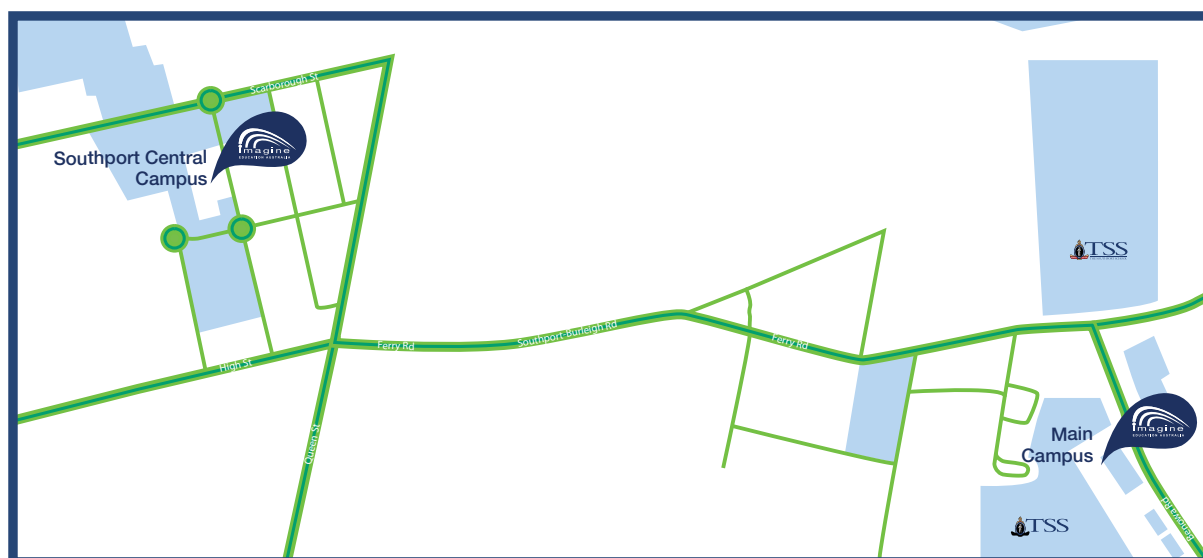
On campus

Living in Australia

Australia is a beautiful country with warm and welcoming people. Australia is very multicultural, and this is reflected in our food, lifestyle, and cultural practices and experiences.¹ Imagine Education Australia is located on the sunny Gold Coast and is Queensland's second largest city, and the sixth largest city in Australia. Read on to learn more about our beautiful Gold Coast and where you'll be living when you study at Imagine Education Australia!

Location and population

The Gold Coast stretches along 70 kilometres of beautiful coastline and boasts one of the most beautiful hinterlands in Australia. Located just one hour drive south from Brisbane and one hour flight from Sydney, with the famous Surfers Paradise only 30 minutes drive from any destination on the Gold Coast. Approximately 500,000 people live on the Gold Coast, making it the sixth largest city in Australia.

Climate and temperature

The Gold Coast is famous for its sunny days and sub-tropical temperatures. Queensland is called "The Sunshine State". On the Gold Coast, we say, "Beautiful one day... perfect the next!". Average temperatures are 19 to 29° Celsius in summer and 9 to 21° Celsius in winter.

Cost of living

The following information has been taken from the Australian Government Study in Australia website: Knowing the average living costs in Australia is an important part of your financial preparation. For your reference, here are some of the costs associated with living and studying in Australia. All costs are in Australian dollars.²

Accommodation

Hostels and guesthouses - \$80 to \$135 per week; Shared rental - \$70 to \$250 per week; Homestay - \$235 to \$270 per week; Individual rental - \$100 to \$400 per week

Other living expenses

Groceries and eating out - \$80 to \$200 per week; Gas, electricity - \$60 to \$100 per week; Phone and internet - \$20 to \$50 per week; Public transport - \$10 to \$50 per week; Car (after purchase) - \$150 to \$250 per week; Entertainment - \$50 to \$100 per week

Transportation: bus, light rail, train, and plane

Local Surfside buses operate from early morning to late at night across the coast and travel to most parts of the Gold Coast. From mid 2014, the Light Rail tram service will connect Southport with Surfers Paradise and Broadbeach. City Train operates a daily direct link, every half an hour, between the Gold Coast (Varsity Lakes) and Brisbane, including the Brisbane International Airport service. 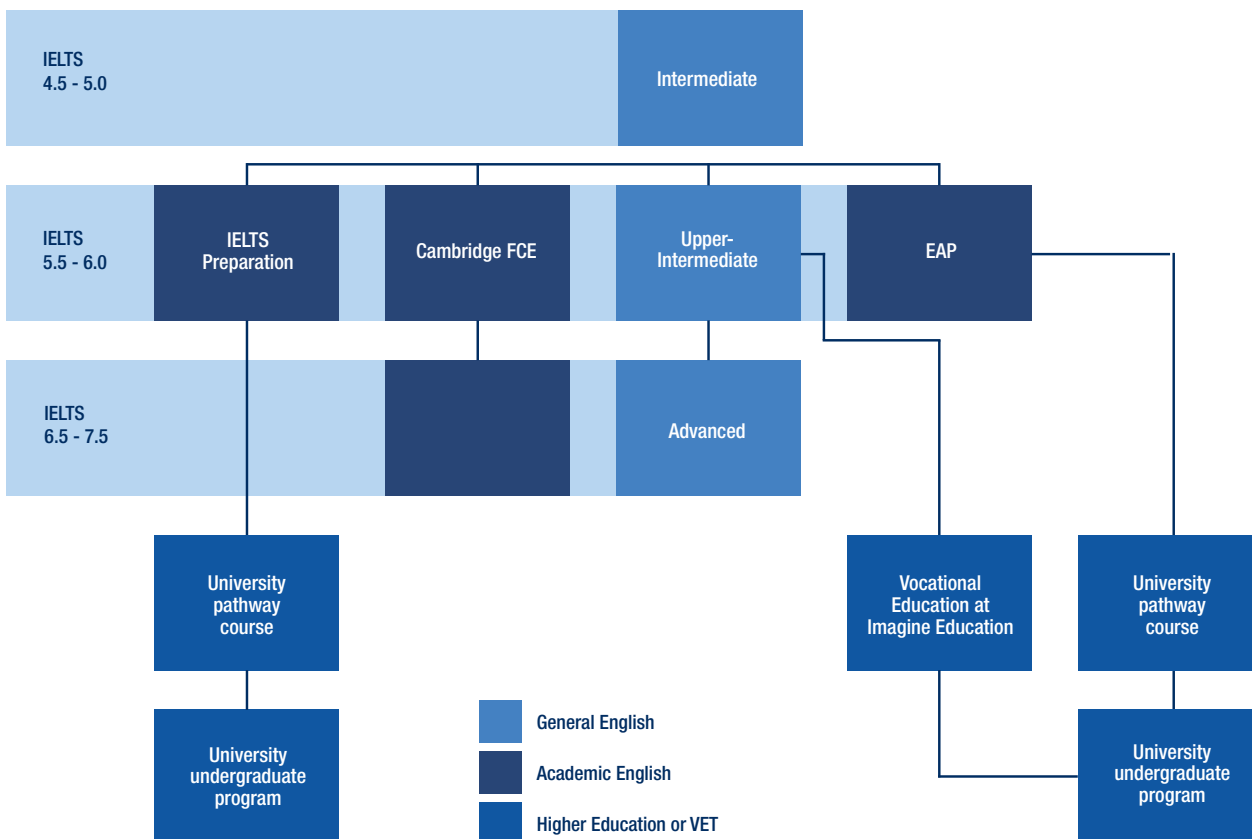

Course code AUR30612

Course length 60 weeks

Career outcomes Automotive mechanic

Articulation pathway Certificate III in Automotive Mechanical Diagnosis

Students are provided with a wide range of fundamental principles relating to industry practices and procedures, including occupational health and safety, repairs, testing, and inspections of automotive mechanical components. Students will be taught to service, repair, and diagnose faults in motor vehicles weighing up to 4.5 tonnes and are also taught how to diagnose, service, and repair faults in light vehicle engines, transmission, suspension, steering, brake, electrical systems, and components. The structure of the course gives students a sound understanding of the vehicles' construction, component identification, and operating principles.



Certificate IV in Automotive Mechanical Diagnosis

Course code AUR40212

Course length 36 weeks

Career outcomes Automotive lead; master technician; automotive technical adviser

This qualification covers the skills and knowledge required to perform advanced diagnostic operations in the automotive retail, service and repair environment. The Certificate IV in Automotive Mechanical Diagnosis provides advanced training for automotive technicians who want to further develop their diagnostic and technical skills. **Those undertaking Certificate IV in Automotive Mechanical Diagnosis are required to have completed an automotive mechanical Certificate III qualification or be able to demonstrate equivalent competency.**

They may provide leadership and guidance with some responsibility for the output of others.

Course length 30 weeks

Articulation pathway Diploma of Marketing; or a range of Diploma level qualifications within the Business Services Training Package

This qualification reflects the role of individuals who use well-developed marketing skills and a broad knowledge base in a wide variety of marketing contexts. They apply solutions to a defined range of unpredictable problems, and analyse and evaluate information from a variety of sources. They may provide leadership and guidance to others with some limited responsibility for the output of others, however they typically report to a more senior marketing practitioner. Depending on the units selected to form the qualification, candidates may complete a generic marketing qualification or specialise in direct marketing, public relations, or international marketing.

Course length 28 weeks

Career outcomes Executive officer; program coordinator; program consultant

Articulation pathway Bond University; CQU

This qualification reflects the role of individuals with substantial experience in a range of settings who are seeking to further develop their skills across a wide range of business functions. This qualification is also suited to the needs of individuals with little or no vocational experience, but who possess sound theoretical business skills and knowledge that they would like to develop in order to create further educational and employment opportunities. Outcomes include advertising, business administration, human resource management, marketing, and management. After obtaining the Diploma of Business, candidates wishing to further their education can undertake Advanced Diploma-level qualifications.

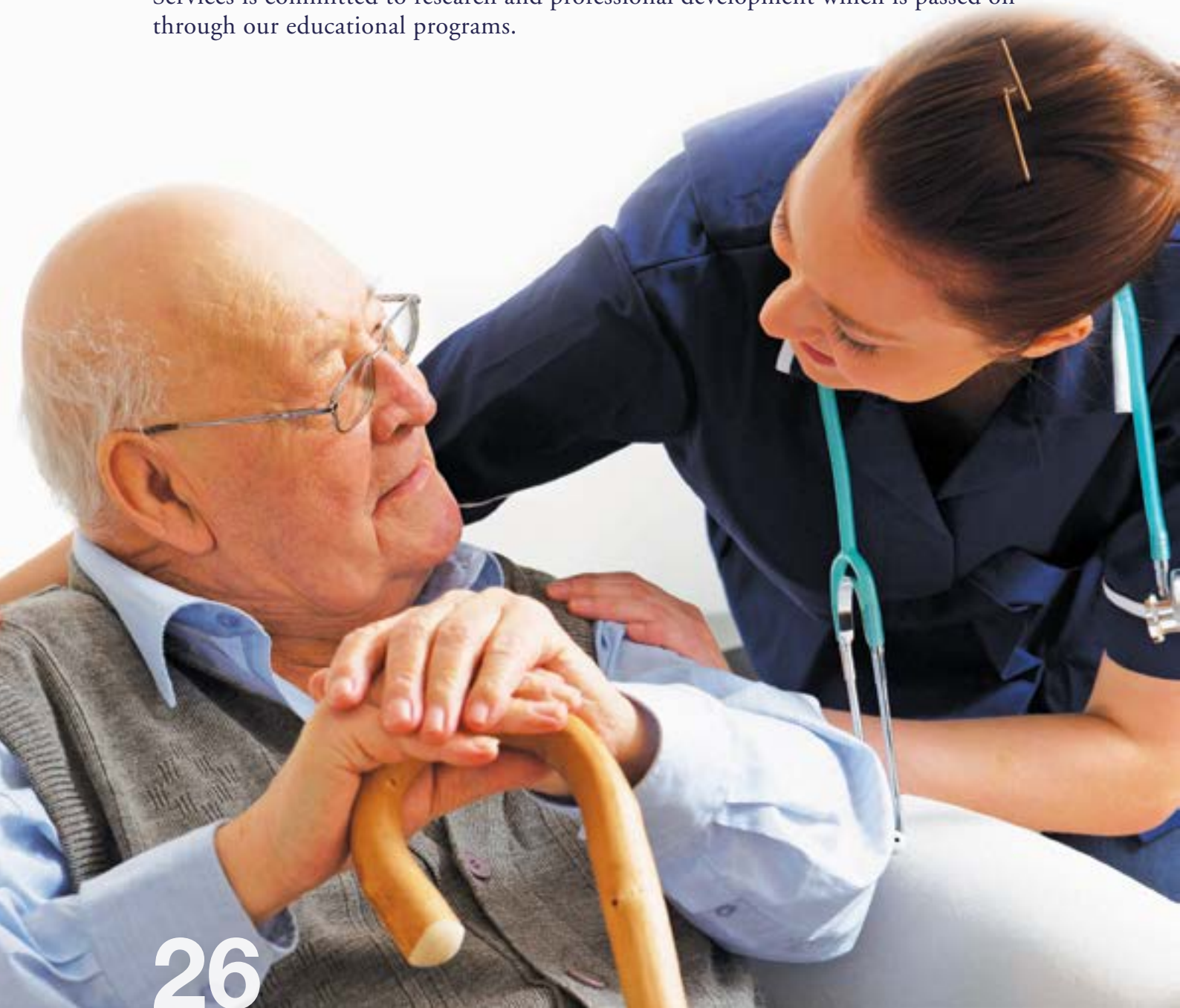
